Why Join?

"I continue to be so thankful to have the MAID Peer group in my life. It is a forum where one can speak about all aspects of a MAID death: why the decision for MAID, the feelings, discussions and thoughts prior to the DATE. Then the actual process of MAID. We learn that each experience is unique and conducted as the person wishes and there are a few funny stories. When it is over, there was, for us, a deep sadness but an overwhelming sense of relief: our David was able to have his wish and to be free of not being able to breathe, speak, swallow etc.

When someone passes away everyone grieves. When approaching a MAID death, the grief starts before the person has died but you have to manage that emotion so as not to upset your loved one who is being so strong and brave. Then when your loved one is gone, you really need people to talk to who have experienced the same type of death. Chatting to someone who is grieving due to a "regular" death is not adequate and actually not very helpful.
